The tournament will be run as a team event, with each team consisting of three players. The initial rounds playing format will be league based. Each team player will play three legs on a round robin basis, resulting in a nine leg match. Two points will be awarded to the winning team and leg difference will come into operation in the event of a tie on points, if this still leaves the teams level the result of the match between the two teams will decide who goes through. Teams may consist of three men / ladies or a combination of men and ladies. Team members must be registered with one of the Beeston & Chilwell Darts Leagues or one of the Nottingham Central Darts Leagues, of last winter or this summer or forthcoming winter seasons. A further rule stipulation is that all the players must play for the team, Pub or Club that are registered with, and that players will not be allowed to mix players from one team to another. (PLEASE NOTE THAT THE ORDER OF PLAY FOR EACH MATCH WILL BE THE ORDER YOU ENTER YOUR TEAM PLAYERS ON THE MATCH SHEETS ON THE DAY.) Beeston darts league rules apply in addition to the rules of play on the day.

The entrance fee is £6 per team, prize monies for the event will be determined by the number of team entrants, with all proceeds being paid out to the winners / runners up & losing semifinalists. All entrance monies from this event WILL be paid out to winning teams. The committee reserve the right to adjust prize monies in accordance with entrance numbers. The winning team in addition to the prize money will hold the Val Bennett Bull Darts Trophy for one year; each team member will also receive an individual trophy. If there are sufficient ladies team entrants they will play within their own groups in the mini league round, the ladies team who progresses the furthest forward shall receive a monetary prize*. There are also prize monies for highest finish & losing semi finalists.

- > THE FIRST ROUND SHALL CONSIST OF LEAGUES OF 3 or 4 TEAMS WITH EACH TEAM PLAYER PLAYING ALL OTHER TEAM PLAYERS IN THEIR LEAGUE.
- ➤ EACH MATCH SHALL CONSIST OF 9 LEGS OF 501, WITH ALL LEGS BEING PLAYED. EACH PLAYER WILL GAIN 2 POINTS FOR EACH MATCH WON.
- > TEAMS SHALL TOSS A COIN FOR EACH MATCH OF 9 LEGS, ONCE ONLY, BEFORE THE START OF THE MATCH. THE TEAM WINNING THE TOSS WILL HAVE THE CHOICE OF ARROWS. ONCE THE COIN HAS BEEN TOSSED TEAMS SHALL CHOOSE THE ORDER OF PLAY AND ENTER THEM ON THE SHEET.
- > ORDER OF PLAY FOR EACH TEAM IS GOVERNED BY THE ORDER YOU HAVE CHOSEN AT THE BOTTOM OF THE MATCH SHEET FOR YOUR TEAM. THE ORDER OF PLAY SHALL REMAIN THE SAME FOR THAT PARTICULAR MATCH. ORDER OF PLAY CAN ONLY BE CHANGED AFTER THE TOSS OF A COIN ON THE COMMENCEMENT OF A NEW MATCH.
- > THE WINNER OF EACH LEAGUE SHALL BE THE TEAM WITH THE MOST POINTS WITH THE RUNNER UP BEING THE TEAM WITH THE SECOND HIGHEST POINT SCORE.
- ➤ IN THE EVENT OF A TIE BETWEEN WINNERS OR RUNNERS UP LEGS DIFFERENCE SHALL BE THE DECIDER. IF THEY RESULTS STILL TIE, THEN THE GAMES WON/LOST BETWEEN THOSE TWO TEAMS SHALL DECIDE THE WINNER AND RUNNER UP RESPECTIVELY.
- > THE 'WINNER' AND RUNNER UP FROM EACH LEAGUE WILL PROCEED TO THE NEXT ROUND.
- > SECOND ROUND STAGES WILL BE THE BEST OF 9 LEGS OF 501 IN A STRAIGHT KNOCKOUT COMPETITION. AGAIN, TOSS FOR CHOICE OF ARROWS ONCE ONLY. AGAIN, ORDER OF PLAY RULE APPLIES.
- > SEMI- FINALS AND THE FINALS SHALL CONSIST OF THE BEST OF 9 LEGS OF 701 IN A STRAIGHT KNOCKOUT FORMAT. AGAIN, ORDER OF PLAY RULE APPLIES.
